Project Need: Outfit a field operations trailer for local agencies to include dispatch, traffic control, crowd monitoring, planning, staging supplies.

Measurable Outcomes:

Background

Describe regional benefit and/or participants: The Central Massachusetts area is a very active area of the commonwealth. Many large gatherings occur on an annual basis including but not limited to sporting events, local festivals and political gatherings. Local first responders lack the central resource platform to perform the most efficient operation. The addition of an trailer capable of storing most commonly used safety equipment will enhance that safety for the general public. The trailer is a package bought trailer that includes installed tables and work stations for a dedicated dispatcher at an event or hostile event. Climate control to keep operators comfortable and able to focus on their job during an event. Onboard generator to supply power to communications and lighting and storage of rehab supplies. In addition, we plan to build out the trailer to accommodate the storage of an inflatable tent and heater, traffic cone storage of one hundred traffic cones, raid deploy barricades, drones, and portable radios.

While the trailer will have the ability to handle large crowd events it will also be able to deploy to hostile threat events. The trailer will be positioned in the staging area to allow for a more visual landmark for arriving mutual aid. Rapid deployment of radios, ballistic vests and helmets and rapid taskforce supplies to include medical bags, patient litters. Each bag and ballistic outfit will be standardized with the same equipment for increased responder efficiency. Radios will be available for seamless operational integration. Traffic safety supplies including traffic cones, barricades can be removed from the trailer and deployed to other areas from the poly box system. Cones will be colored to signify different working areas and have the flexibility to be setup reunification areas, evacuation areas as well as barricading off areas during the event.

This resource will assist area department in centralizing the supplies needed to respond to events with large crowds and quickly deploy during hostile threat events. The lack of manpower to deploy the resources is decreased to a small number of responders. Bolton is centrally located to Fire Districts six, seven, eight and fourteen and would be able to deliver the trailer along with members that would be able to setup the trailer including FAA certified drone pilots that can assist with deployment and tracking of equipment during an event.

Proposed Activity: This project will procure thirty (30) Night Vision Devices with mounts and battery packs for the Central Massachusetts Law Enforcement Council (CEMLEC) SWAT team. This equipment is essential to sustain the SWAT team's anti-terrorism capabilities in the Central region.

Project Need: This project would bring the equipment the team needs to function at night up to modern standards. The night vision devices are needed in order to allow the CEMLEC SWAT team to maintain all-weather and all-aspect capability to deploy at any hour. There are many instances where time is of the essence, in a hostage scenario for example, and being forced to wait until daybreak would put both team personnel as well as civilians in unnecessary risk. CEMLEC SWAT is one of the few Teams in the state that does not have this vital piece of equipment. And interoperability with other SWAT Teams such as METRO SWAT which our Team shares security and counter terrorism responsibilities at Gillette Stadium for all events to include the World Cup this year. In 2013 both our Teams worked together at the Marathon bombing and man hunt and it is imperative this request gets put forward, and in a timely manner. The costs of this equipment are orders of magnitude past what the LEC is able to provide with its own operating budget

Measurable Outcomes: The equipment procured under this project will allow the CEMLEC SWAT team to train for and deploy to dangerous situations to effectively respond to threats such as a barricaded subject, active shooter, and other similar terror related incidents. Sustaining this anti-terrorism capability is key to protecting the Central region. This project will allow the team to perform at a high standard as they have done in the past in high-risk situations. And have interoperability with other Teams when the need arises.

Background (e.g.: continuation of previous project, funding limitations, etc.): The Central Massachusetts LECs have increasingly been working together over many past federal funding years fulfilling training and exercise investments, cooperative procurements, and tactical gear. The LECs have worked consistently to

assist the Councils to build up the following capabilities: unarmed barricaded persons, armed barricaded persons, hostage situations, high risk search warrants and other life-threatening incidents.

Describe regional benefit and/or participants: *CEMLEC SWAT Team is a regional Team that covers over 62 cities and towns in the Central Region. This piece of equipment will bring the Team up to modern standards to help aid not only the Team but the region in which it covers to be better prepared to serve and protect.*

Proposed Activity:

To purchase 1 mobile trailer package with movable barricades, chains, gates, signs etc... For regional use during elections, special events, and mass gatherings.

Project Need:

The region needs assets to effectively mitigate the Hostile Vehicle Incident (HVI) threat. This equipment will allow barriers to be deployed at the perimeter of polling locations, streets, special events, or other Mass gatherings.

Measurable Outcomes:

We will measure the effectiveness of this project by tracking the number of deployments throughout the region, the number of municipalities PD/FD/DPW/EM departments being trained on deploying the assets. Additionally, after deployments we will request feedback from the municipality on how the asset improved security of the event. Finally, in the event of a HVI or accidental vehicle incident occurs – we can analyze the effectiveness of the barricades as compared to how the incident may have occurred with out safety barricades in place.

Background (e.g.: continuation of previous project, funding limitations, etc.):

Vehicle Ramming Attacks or Hostile Incidents have been increasing in occurrences globally. Violent extremists and Foreign Terrorist Organizations are increasingly encouraging these attacks, as well as disseminating videos and articles on planning and executing these attacks. Polling locations around the region typically have long lines, exposing voters and election workers to vehicle ramming attacks. In the North Central Mass area alone, there are numerous Special events that attract over 10,000 people from all over the district requiring a multitude of streets to be blocked to prevent HVI's. Saw horses and hay bails do not provide adequate security and the amount of backhoes, dump trucks and other vehicles to block the roads are hard to come by and cost prohibitive to provide.

Not only are there numerous festivals and events in Fitchburg that require protection from HVI, but in the neighboring cities and towns in North Central Mass there are additional festivals requiring the same road security, Unprotected polling locations and University Graduations.

These barricades will be part of many multiple -jurisdictional Emergency Action plans. As of right now road security and blockages have been included in these EAP's already. The non-availability of these type of blockades. Have caused an exasperation of resources. From Saw-horses and hay bales (that do not provide adequate protection) to DPW vehicles (Backhoes and Dump trucks) that are not enough and are not cost effective to deploy.

All possible other means of funding will be investigated to continue to acquire a cache of equipment to provide adequate security to all regional partners.

If we are awarded this grant. Fitchburg Emergency Management plans to keep this equipment stored and ready to deploy if any of our regional partners need assistance.

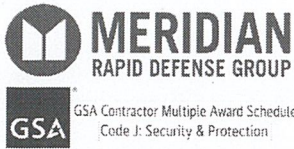
